Member of the Year Award

Award to be presented by the Sorority to the Member who best meets the proposed criteria. The award is presented at the Regional Conference on an annual basis.

- A. Type of Award – Inscribed plaque, if budget allows
- B. Criteria of member nominated:
  - 1. Be a financial member of Chi Eta Phi Sorority, Inc. (Local, Regional, and National).
  - 2. Be actively involved in the local, regional, and national activities and programs.
  - 3. Have attended the most recent Regional meeting.
  - 4. Have attended a Boule' within the last four years prior to nomination for award.
  - 5. Support should be within a two year period immediately prior to the nomination.
  - 6. Service above and beyond expectation of membership.
    - a. Developing a program that further advances the Sorority and to which the member provides direct involvement.
    - b. Helping to promote any of the National Programs and Projects
    - c. Assisting to promote the sustainability and longevity of the Sorority.
- C. Procedure
  - 1. Each chapter may submit one member for nomination.
  - 2. All nominations with supporting data are to be sent to the Awards Committee Chair by the designated timeframe
  - 3. The Awards committee will select the awardee based on the above criteria.
  - 4. The Awards Committee Chair will forward selection to the Midwest Regional Director two weeks prior to the beginning of the Midwest Regional Conference.
  - 5. The Awards Committee Chair will order the plaque and present it to the awardee at the Regional Conference.
